



First of all: Grace Kelly did not choose the name as an artist name. **Her parents gave her this name** that now stands for an urban multicultural party sound that takes you from Brazil and Latinamerica to the Orient and the Far East.

DJane Grace Kelly, who is origin from Bahia (Brazil), came to Berlin in 1996. Fascinated by the multicultural metropolis with its

different sounds she began to mix the music from her Afrobrasilian background, like Latin and Brazil, with influences of Drum'n'Bass, Electronics and even Oriental Breakbeats and Eastern European music.

Since 2000 she has regular shows in different clubs in Berlin (Germany) as well as bookings to different venues and festivals all around Germany (like Pop d'Europe, Heimatklänge, Samba Syndrom, Tanz- und Folkfestival, Rudolstadt) and even all over the world. London, (Mikonos), Bar and restaurant KudeTa, Kuta (Bali), Trancoso (Brazil), Udine (Italy) are some of the places DJ Grace Kelly made happy with her music. Since these times she became one of Berlin's most famous DJs who is well-known for furious shows for eyes, ears and of course feet.

Beside her work on the decks, turntables and mixers she is working with the female Brazil group „**Rainhas do Norte**“ and „**Furiosas**“ as drummer. Groups, that are well-known for shows at the „Karneval der Kulturen“, Germany's biggest multicultural Carnival event in Berlin and different festivals like the worldmusic festival „Tanz- und Folkfest“ in Rudolstadt.

In 2003 DJ Grace Kelly established her **own permanent party event called "mundo mix"**, the total-global-party, located at the hip club „Pfefferberg“ in Berlin at every second Saturday.

Since 2004 she had her own radio show „**Selektor – Brazil Beats**“ at the public radio station Radio Multikulti where she was regularly presenting the hottest sounds from Brazil.
